## The Health Industry Context in Greater Shepparton




GV Health is the largest employer in the Goulburn Valley with over 2,000 staff across five sites. This will grow by at least 500 people in the coming five years as GV Health embark upon stage two of their redevelopment. Aged and disability care is also a major sector providing employment within our region. Within Hume region in 2017 2,500 people were employed in this sector. Due to the NDIS and aging population significant growth is apparent within aged and disability care sector. The need for 2018 anticipated an additional 500 workers within Hume Region to meet demand. The range of jobs within the health sector include medical and non-medical as well as a range of trades, catering, procurement, records management
