



Carl and Hannah Lenne started growing fruit in 1889 in Ardmona, Northern Victoria. Today, Carl and Hannah's great-grandson Andrew Plunkett manages the family business, growing fruit across 195 hectares and packing fresh fruit that is now exported to more than 30 countries.

Located in the Goulburn Valley, Australia's premier fruit-growing zone, Plunkett Orchards produces apples, pears, apricots and peaches.

The fruits grown at Plunkett Orchards are a mix of traditional and new varieties that are picked between November and May each year.

A range of businesses are associated with Plunkett Orchards, building on the knowledge and experience of the Plunkett family to deliver services and high quality food and beverage products.

Rigorous grading procedures ensure that fruit processed at Plunkett Orchards is of the highest quality.

The grading process is enhanced by the latest in digital scanning technology and split-second weighing equipment that sorts fruit by size into cartons, wooden fruit bins or cardboard hat bins.


Further, each piece of fruit is visually assessed by staff and rejected if size, shape or appearance does not meet set standards.


Fruit is cool stored in a modern Controlled Atmosphere facility with a capacity of 16,000 bins (8,000 tonnes).






ANDREW PLUNKETT
